

Pathway 1 Trade Skills Assessment Process

Assessor reviews training and employment evidence to ensure candidate has:
- sufficient employment experience
- the skills and knowledge required to work in their trade in Australia.

Apply for a Trade Skills Assessment and provide evidence Apply and upload training and employment evidence online. Submit payment to Trades Recognition Australia. Stage 1: Evidence Review

Sufficient

Sufficient evidence to progress to the next stage of assessment.

Insufficient

Insufficient evidence to progress to the next stage of assessment. Unsuccessful Stage 1 outcomes are reviewed by TRA.

Candidate can:

accept decision (application closed)
 apply for reassessment
 apply for a review.

Stage 2: Technical Interview or/and Practical Assessment:

Applicants in non-licensed trades must complete a Technical Interview. Applicants in licensed trades must complete both a Practical Assessment and a Technical Interview. All Stage 2 assessment outcomes are reviewed by TRA.

Successful Outcome

Non-licensed trade candidates receive:

- Successful Assessment Outcome Letter
 - Australian qualification
 - Statement of Results.

Licensed trade candidates receive:

- Successful Assessment Outcome Letter - Offshore Technical Skills Record.

Unsuccessful Outcome

Non-licensed trade candidates receive:

- Unsuccessful Assessment Outcome Letter - Statement of Results
 - Statement of Attainment.

Licensed trade candidates receive:

- Unsuccessful Assessment Outcome Letter.

Candidate can:

accept decision (application closed)
 apply for reassessment
 apply for a review.
