### Job description

A Snowsport Instructor coaches, trains and instructs participants in snow skiing, snowboarding or other snow sports by analysing their performances and developing their abilities.

### Snowsport Instructor is a VETASSESS Group D occupation

This occupation requires a qualification assessed as comparable to the educational level of an Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Certificate III or IV.

Applicants can fulfil the assessment criteria for this occupation in one of four ways.

## Pathways 1–3

minimum years of post-qualification employment highly relevant to the nominated occupation, completed at an appropriate skill level in the five years before the date of application for a Skills Assessment.

## Pathway 4

minimum 4 years of relevant employment required – Three years of relevant employment (can be outside the last 5-year period) in addition to at least one year of highly relevant employment within the last five years before applying.

A positive assessment of both qualification level and employment duration is required for a positive Skills Assessment outcome.



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## Qualification

This occupation requires a qualification assessed as comparable to the education level of an Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Certificate III or higher and in a field highly relevant to the nominated occupation. This includes qualifications assessed at AQF Certificate III, Certificate IV, Diploma, Associate Degree, Bachelor Degree, Graduate Diploma, Master or Doctoral level. Highly relevant major fields of study include:

- › Sports Coaching and Instruction, which is the study of the techniques for coaching and instructing individuals and teams in various sporting activities.

## Employment Tasks

Highly relevant tasks include, but are not limited to:

- › Coaching, training and instructing sportspersons by analysing performances and developing abilities
- › Planning and directing game strategies, developing play patterns and analysing game progress
- › Motivating sportspersons and supervising practice sessions
- › Recruiting players and other coaching staff
- › Arranging entries into sporting competitions
- › Promoting sports and skills development, and overseeing the participation of young people in sport
- › Officiating at sporting events to enforce rules
- › Coordinating and directing sporting activities, and liaising with other officials to interpret and enforce rules and regulations relating to sport.

## Further requirements may apply

The requirements outlined in this information sheet is relating to VETASSESS skills assessments for migration purposes. In relation to professionally practising the occupation in Australia, additional accreditation requirements may apply. Applicants are required to perform their own research to determine any additional accreditation requirements.
