Job description

An Operating Theatre Technician prepares and maintains an operating theatre and its equipment, assists the surgical team during operations and provides support to patients in the recovery room.


Operating Theatre Technician is a VETASSESS Group D occupation

This occupation requires a qualification assessed as comparable to the educational level of an Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Certificate III or higher.

Applicants can fulfil the assessment criteria for this occupation in four different ways.

Qualification and employment criteria

Applicants must have fulfilled at least one of the following four criteria (1-4):



(20 hours or more per week)

minimum years of post-qualification employment highly relevant to the nominated occupation, completed at an appropriate skill level in the five years before the date of application for a Skills Assessment.

Pathway 4

minimum 4 years of relevant employment required - Three years of relevant employment (can be outside the last 5-year period) in addition to at least one year of highly relevant employment within the last five years before applying.

A positive assessment of both qualification level and employment duration is required for a positive Skills Assessment outcome.

Qualification

This occupation requires a qualification as comparable to the education level of an AQF Certificate III or higher. This includes qualifications assessed at AQF Certificate III, Certificate IV, Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Associate Degree, Bachelor Degree, Graduate Diploma, Master and Doctoral level.

Employment Tasks

Tasks include but are not limited to:

- > Setting up, checking and maintaining operating theatres, anaesthetic workstations, life support machines and associated equipment
- > transporting patients to and from the theatre and wards
- > assisting in preparing operating rooms for surgery
- > setting up, checking, connecting and adjusting
- > provide technical assistance to surgeons, surgical nurses and anaesthetists
- > cleaning and restocking the operating room, arranging instruments, supplies and equipment according to instruction
- > positioning patients for surgical and anaesthetic treatments.
